 Every February, people in Canada are invited to participate in Black History Month festivities and events that honour the legacy of Black Canadians and their communities.  
 The 2021 theme for Black History Month is: "The Future is Now" - a chance to celebrate and acknowledge the transformative work that Black Canadians and their communities are doing now.

The Pan-African flag—also known as the Afro-American flag, Black Liberation flag, UNIA flag and various other names—is a tri-color flag consisting of three equal horizontal bands of (from top down) red, black and green.



The Universal Negro College Association and African Communities League (UNIA-ACL) formally adopted it on August 11, 1931, in Article 59 of the Declaration of the Rights of the Negro Peoples of the World, during its month-long convention at Madison Square Garden in New York City. Variations of the flag can and have been used in various countries and territories in the Americas to represent Caribbean identities.
