Q. Your passion?


A. It's adventure, travel, cultures and as J. Green sings, "I am in love with cities I've never been to and people I've never met."

Q. Best advice you have ever received?


A. "Wherever you go, go with all your heart."

Q. What are you most proud of?


A. To have worked on four continents.
